Progress Status up to May 20, 2020:

With intellectual and financial support of soon valley diaspora comprising Dr Muhammad Khalid Riaz, Dr Naheed Qayyum, Dr Ghaus Malik and Dr Tariq Awan, HDF Pakistan has been able to ensure adequate nutritional requirements of 345 most vulnerable families in Soon Valley badly affected by the unprecedented COVID-19 situation. The composition of each ration pack was decided by our Nutritionist to cater for the required nutritional need of an average family of seven individuals for one month.

Distribution of Ration Packs:

Most affected 345 families from Soon Valley were selected in consultation with local community for provision of the ration packs. Food items included in ration packs were procured from respective towns/villages in soon valley by a committee comprising HDF

staff from National Office and village people, in accordance with the procurement policy. The ration packs were packed and distributed jointly by HDF staff and committee members. Branding of HDF was done on every ration pack. Town/Village wise distribution in Soon Valley Khushab is under:
